## **AUTUMN TERM INFORMATION FOR F2 PARENTS**

Welcome to our first term at St. Wilfrid's.

I hope that you have all had a great summer and that your children have enjoyed starting school with us. Here is some key information that I hope you will find helpful.

We start our day by collecting the class from the playground at 8.50am. After organising our belongings, we have registration and carpet time to introduce our activities for the day. At the end of the day (3.30pm) the children are sent out one at a time to their parent or carer on the playground. Children at S-Club are collected by a member of S-Club staff. What to bring:

Each day your child will need to bring to school their water bottle (named), book bag and coat.

Our PE lesson with Mr Devivo is on a Thursday so this is the day that your child will need to come to school in their PE kits. Our second PE lesson is movement in the hall where children will just take off their shoes and socks. ## **Reading Books**

Your child will choose books to bring home that you can read and enjoy with them. This is to help develop their vocabulary and love of books, we ask that you record the books that you have read to your child in their reading diary. We will then track their daily reads at home on individual reading tracks at the front of diaries and celebrate their achievements.

During the first half term we will start sending home reading scheme books for your child to read to you. These start with no words (where your child will tell their own story using the pictures) and progress to words that are made up of the sounds that your child has learnt and will therefore be able to practise their reading. They will practise these books in group reading sessions before bringing them home. This is a different way of reading and sharing books at home which forms an essential part of our reading scheme: Little Wandle Letters and Sounds. There will be a meeting with more information about this on <u>Monday 16th September at 6.00pm</u>. which we hope you are able to attend.

Every day your child is entitled to a free piece of fruit. They also receive daily free milk until their 5th birthday. Once your child has turned 5 if you would like them to continue to have school milk you need to register and pay online at <u>www.coolmilk.com</u>
